

GREEN SPORTS ACADEMY

PROJECT: CHILDREN SOCCER CLINIC

OBJECTIVE: The idea behind this project is to offer children (5 to 12yrs) in the community the opportunity to be trained by qualified soccer coaches, to develop and enhance their soccer skills. It also creates the room for parents to entrust their wards in the hands of capable trained coaches, to allow parents to attend to their busy weekend schedules. This project also provides an employment opportunity for trained coaches to impart skills to these young ones.

WORKING PLAN:

This project is expected to be held every SATURDAY between 9a.m to 12noon at selected parks within Tema and Accra (Community 11 Complex School Park and Don Bosco CPC Park). It is estimated that every park will have at least 50 children and 2 qualified coaches who will take the children through a well-planned course outline.

Every participating child will pay a registration fee of GHC 100 to be a member of the program, and also pay GHC 50 for every weekend training session. Upon registration every participant will receive a jersey, stocking and membership ID card. In addition, snacks will be served to every participant after a training session.

BENEFITS OF PROJECT

- A. Participants will get the chance to meet soccer legends and administrators and interact with them to know more about the game of football.
- B. Exceptional talents that will be discovered through this program will be scouted to be enrolled into Green Sports Academy FC to pursue their professional soccer careers.
- C. Foreign scouts will be invited periodically to come over and scout for talents.

PROFILE OF GREEN SPORTS ACADEMY

Green Sports Academy is a sporting organization established to identify and develop sporting talents and also nurture those talents into professionals with international repute.

The organization seeks to provide facilities such as soccer pitches and Boxing Gymnasium necessary for the training and grooming of young talents between the ages of 12-23 to meet international standard and market.

In line with our objective, the Green Sports Academy periodically organizes sporting competitions and workshops within localities in its catchment area and beyond to unearth talents for the Academy. This program targets talents within the age range of 5-23 years. The Organization has a Football Team which is preparing to play in the Division Three Soccer League in Ghana.
