**A REQUEST FOR AN INDEPENDENT INVESTIGATION INTO THE GRUESOME  
MURDER OF BONAVENTURE SEI MIREKU DANQUAH IN NKWANTA AND THE  
PROSECUTION OF NANA AMOAH (Adele Chief – Nkwanta) AND ACCOMPLICE JONAS  
BOAFO (Amankrado – Dadiase)**

It is with a heavy heart that I make this request on behalf of my siblings and the entire Royal family of the Guan Akyode Traditional Area for the investigation and prosecution of Nana Amoah (Adele Chief of Nkwanta) and Nana Monfankye (Chief, Dadiase), all in the Nkwanta South Municipal Assembly in Oti Region for the murder of our brother, Bonaventure Sei Mireku Danquah and the burning of our three-bedroom, fully furnished house located at Nsana Zongo in Nkwanta.

Attached is a notification that we, as siblings, (children of Nana Oberko Agyei II, the late Paramount Chief of the Akyode Traditional Area) served to the then Chairman of the Oti Regional Security Council, and copied to the Oti Regional Commander of Police, the North Volta Regional Commander of Police, the chairman of the Nkwanta South Municipal Security Council, the Municipal Commander, Ghana Police Service, Nkwanta, the Divisional Commander, Nkwanta, which sought to report the actions of our primary suspects, Nana Amoah (Adele Chief of Nkwanta) and Nana Monfankye (Chief of Dadiase whose Amankrado Jonas Boafo came to our house to threaten our brother, Bonaventure Sei Mireku Danquah, and his siblings in the diaspora.

The deceased who signed the letters handed two copies to the land Surveyor to deliver to Nana Monfankye and Nana Amoah. Those addressed to the Regional Commander, the two commanders in Nkwanta, the Chairman of the Nkwanta South Municipal Security Council were delivered in person by the deceased to the MCE office and a police officer at post the same day 6<sup>th</sup> January 2025. That of the Chairman of the Regional Security Council and the North Volta Regional Police commander were delivered electronically. Bonaventure made a follow up call to Mr. Gboxoxo seeking advice and the latter asked him to contact the region because the letter was addressed to the Region and only copied to them (evidence available).

Attached to this letter are two audio recordings (USB drive) attesting to our suspicion of Nana Amoah and Mr. Jonas Boafo and a printed copy of the notification that was served to the various parties mentioned. Our prime suspects on numerous occasions sent assigns (and Mr. Jonas Boafo also went in person) to stop the construction of the wall. Below is a list of individuals who have also engaged them on our behalf and individuals who accompanied our brother as witnesses.

The following persons have also engaged with both Nana Amoah and Nana Monfankye on behalf of the family directly and indirectly:

1. The Oti Regional Commander of Police, who asked ASP Gboxoxo to invite Nana Amoah for questioning.
2. DCOP Kofi Blagogie (Regional Commander, North Volta Hohoe, called on the ASP Asiedu and Gboxoxo to express his interest in the matter after we called on him to intervene because we realized reluctance from the Police in Nkwanta who showed little or no interest in our continuous call on them to intervene).
3. Hon. Daniel Machator (Former Regional Minister, Oti)
4. Hon. Felix Owusu-Gyimah (Former MCE, Nkwanta)
5. Hon. Divine Ankamah (Assemblyman, Dadiase).
6. Mr. Buor (a.k.a Big George, Nkwanta)
7. Mr. Edward Kofi Owusu Esq (Accra)
8. Mr. Joseph Kwame Ofori (Land Surveyor, Nkwanta)
9. Mr. Vincent Antwi (GES, Nkwanta)
10. Rev. Fr. Joseph Opoku (St. Joseph Hospital, Nkwanta)
11. Madam Justina Nsana – Asato (a witness and signee of the receipt to the land, who equally was present when pillars were raised at the boundaries).
12. Two neighbours Mr. Wakasimuna, in whose house Bonaventure's dead body was found and one Forestry Commission official accompanied him to Nana Amoah.

Bonaventure went to make an official complaint to the police about a threat to his life by the two persons (Nana Amoah and Jonas, Amankrado of Dadiase) that of his wife and the other residents of the house as well as a threat to destroy our house.

The newly built and furnished three-bedroom self-contained house was set ablaze on Thursday, 16<sup>th</sup> January 2025 around 8:00 PM, and while seeking to escape, Bonaventure was shot multiple times to death. His body was found on the premises of the house next to ours.

We request that Bonaventure's murder be investigated independently given the circumstances surrounding the threats directed to him by Mr. Jonas Boafo (Amankrado) and Nana Amoah's expression of not wanting a 'scorpion' in his pocket, obviously because, our house is situated on a piece of land situated in an Adele dominated area.

Given the apparent lack of interest of the police personnel in addressing the numerous complaints made to their outfit about the threat to Bonaventure's life and the property, we humbly request that the

investigation into the matter should not be entrusted to the local police neither those in the Oti region. We have the feeling (a general public feeling and impression) that at least, the police personnel including those engaged in investigating criminal activities in this catchment area may have been in one way or another compromised. We humbly request that the charge office provides a written statement of Bonaventure's complaints to their outfit. In order to arrive at the truth of the matter and for justice served to the perpetrators, an external investigative body should be engaged. We are ready and available to assist in investigating this case.
