Clean Jobs Company Limited categorically denies all allegations made by the Western North Regional Minister in an interview with JoyNews, claiming our company's involvement in illegal mining activities within the Tano Anwia Forest Reserve.

We would like to clarify the following points:

1. Commitment to Legal Operations

Clean Jobs Company Limited is a reputable organization dedicated to upholding the highest standards of environmental protection and legal compliance. We have no engagement or interest in illegal mining operations and operate strictly within the bounds of the law. Our activities in the region are conducted in full accordance with Ghanaian regulations, under the minerals and mining act, act 703. And we maintain transparency in all of our operations as owners of the said concession. Clean Jobs has not officially commenced operations on its concession within the Forest Reserve, and has only been at the forefront of fighting illicit galamsey operators from and within its concession boundaries.

2. Clarification of Operations

We operate with the utmost respect for environmental conservation, and as a responsible company, we ensure all our operations undergo rigorous environmental and legal assessments before commencement. At no point have we engaged in or supported any activities that could potentially harm the Tano Anwia Forest Reserve or its ecosystem. We must also state that, the act of illegality is been perpetrated by intruders on our concession, and some party faithfuls within the current regime. This act has denied us, access to our legitimately acquired concessions with mining leases and all other legally required permits both from the EPA and Forestry Commission.

3. **Commitment to the Environment and Local Communities**

Clean Jobs Company Limited has always been an advocate for responsible and sustainable development. We actively engage in initiatives aimed at improving the livelihoods of local communities and preserving natural resources. Any accusations to the contrary are completely unfounded and do not reflect the values that drive our company.

We invite the Western North Regional Minister and all relevant stakeholders to engage with us in a constructive dialogue to clarify the misunderstanding. We are committed to resolving this matter through open communication and ensuring the accuracy of information being presented to the public.

We are confident that a thorough investigation will reveal the truth of our operations, and we are prepared to fully cooperate with any inquiries or reviews into our activities.
