President Mahama And Acting Chief Justice To Grace Swearing-In Of Newly-elected National Executive Of GJA.

Accra, July 9, 2025 – The President of the Republic, His Excellency John Dramani Mahama, and the Acting Chief Justice, His Lordship Justice Paul Baffoe-Bonnie, will grace the swearing-in ceremony for the newly-elected National Executive of the Ghana Journalists Association (GJA).

The event is scheduled for Friday, July 11, 2025, at the Accra International Conference Centre, at 9:00 AM. The Ghana Journalists Association is honored to announce that President John Dramani Mahama will be the Special Guest of Honour while His Lordship Justice Paul Baffoe-Bonnie will administer the oaths to the newly-elected National Executive Members.

They will work to consolidate past gains and strive for an even more robust, ethical, professional, and independent media that contributes meaningfully to good governance and national development.
