DETAILS FOR MEDIA COVERAGE OF THE STATE FUNERAL FOR THE DEPARTED EIGHT (8).

Media houses and their representatives are invited to cover the state funeral for our gallant eight who fell in the line of duty. This solemn event will be conducted according to specific arrangements.

To ensure a well-organised event, Journalists and all media houses wishing to cover the State Funeral are advised to note the following essential arrangements:

Accreditation:

- Limited accreditation will be granted to photographers and camera operators to access the special media zone within the inner perimeter.
- This is to ensure optimal space and decorum during the ceremony.
- Reporters are welcome to join the mourners and well-wishers or access the media stands, which do not require any form of accreditation.

Accreditation Application Deadline:

 Applications for accreditation must be submitted by media houses for photographers and camera operators ONLY via email to <u>accreditation@isd.gov.gh</u> by midday (noon GMT) on Wednesday, 13 August 2025.

Clean Feed Availability:

- To facilitate comprehensive live coverage, Presidency Communications will provide a dedicated CLEAN FEED for all local and international TV stations and other media houses wishing to air the event live on their channels.
- The feed will be available on site and our dedicated Outdoor Broadcast channel on the DTH decoder.
- This feed will be the primary source for the live broadcast.

Studio Discussions/Live Broadcasts:

- Radio and TV stations, along with other media outlets planning studio discussions or live remote broadcasts, will be assigned a designated area.
- There will be access points to connect for the clean video feed and audio.
- This area does not require accreditation.
