Let's build a secure, prosperous, and just Ghana.

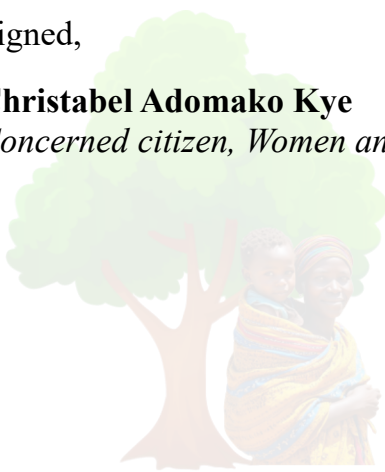
