## **PUBLIC NOTICE**

### **CAUTION TO THE GENERAL PUBLIC ON FRAUDULENT EMAILS AND IMPERSONATION**

The Minerals Commission wishes to bring to the attention of the general public, stakeholders, and participants within the mining sector that it has recently received reports of fraudulent emails and communications being circulated by individuals impersonating staff of the Commission.

These individuals are falsely presenting themselves as officials of the Minerals Commission and using unofficial email addresses and digital platforms to contact members of the public, investors, and companies under the pretext of facilitating mineral licenses, permits, registrations, payments, or other regulatory services. In some instances, these impersonators attempt to solicit money or request sensitive information, claiming to act on behalf of the Commission.

The Minerals Commission wishes to unequivocally state that these communications are fraudulent and do not originate from the Commission or any of its authorized officers. The Commission does not request payments or confidential information through unofficial channels, private email accounts, or third-party intermediaries. All official correspondence from the Commission is conducted through authorized institutional channels.

The public is therefore strongly advised to exercise caution when dealing with individuals or entities claiming to represent the Minerals Commission. Stakeholders are encouraged to verify all communications and avoid making payments or sharing sensitive information with unknown persons who claim to act on behalf of the Commission.

Anyone who receives suspicious messages, emails, or requests relating to the activities of the Minerals Commission is encouraged to immediately report the matter to the Commission for verification and further action.

The Minerals Commission remains committed to protecting the integrity of Ghana's mineral administration system and safeguarding the interests of the public and legitimate stakeholders in the mining sector. The Commission will continue to work with relevant authorities to address and prevent fraudulent activities conducted in its name.
