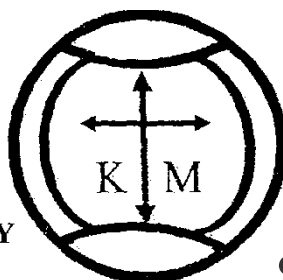

Introduction

We, the members of The Knights and Ladies of Marshall, join our shepherds of the Ghana Catholic Bishops' Conference in affirming their recent statement on matters of human dignity, family, and national discourse. As a Catholic Society, we stand united with the Bishops in their pastoral concern for the moral and social flourishing of our nation.

Affirmation of Our Bishops' Message

- We support our Bishops' reminder that economic progress and moral coherence are not rivals but companions.
- We echo their conviction that questions of marriage, sexuality, and family are not trivial, but central to the health of society.
- We uphold their twin principles: the inviolable dignity of every human person, and the responsibility to protect the family founded upon the union of man and woman.

On National Dialogue

We share our Bishops' concern that dismissing these debates as a "waste of time" risks alienating citizens for whom these matters are deeply significant. We therefore call for dialogue marked by respect, seriousness, and clarity, so that our nation may be built on trust and shared values.


On Legislative Matters

We affirm the Bishops' call for careful scrutiny of the Human Sexual Rights and Family Values Bill, ensuring that it reflects both the moral convictions of Ghanaians and the constitutional commitment to human dignity. We urge fidelity to democratic integrity and respect for publicly stated commitments.

As a Catholic society, we pledge to continue supporting our Bishops in their mission to guide the faithful and to contribute to national conversations with wisdom, charity, and justice. May Ghana be strengthened in both economic aspiration and moral foundation, for the good of generations yet unborn.
