PETITION TO CHALLENGE THE CREDIBILITY OF THE CERTIFICATE OF MR. PIUS ACHEAMPONG FOR THE 2026 CONSTITUENCY ELECTION OF THE NEW PATRIOTIC PARTY IN SUAME CONSTITUENCY

According to Rule 17 section 'f' of the Rules and Regulations of 2026 internal elections page 19 states that; **Qualification & Eligibility.**

“In the case of Constituency Secretary, Research Officer and Electoral Affairs Officer, the Applicant must have at least a Diploma or higher qualification”.

Furthermore, Rule 18 of the Rules and Regulations again explains that;

“It is the duty of an aspiring Constituency Executive to satisfy the Constituency Elections Committee that he/she has met all the above qualifications and eligibility requirements”.

Therefore, I pray the committee to validate the originality of the certificate of Mr. Pius Acheampong and pray the committee to verify from the institution whose name bears the certificate of which I am prepare to bear any financial commitment.

These Rules and Regulations governing the conduct of the Party's internal elections are made pursuant to Article 7 and other relevant provisions of the Constitution of the New Patriotic Party (NPP) as amended, which confers the National Council with the authority to prescribe guidelines for the effective administration and operation of the Party at all levels.

The National Executive Committee (NEC) and the National Council (NC) went further to release detailed Rules and Regulations as approved to govern the conduct of the impending constituency elections.

The New Patriotic Party Outlines Rules And Regulations For The Conduct Of The Internal Elections Of The Party To Select Party Executives From Polling Station Level To National Level.

This petition is presented to the constituency election vetting committee pursuant to *Rule 17(f) and 18* to address the open violation of the rules and regulations and the decisions of the two highest decision-making bodies outside the National Annual Delegates Conference and National Congress of the party.

As at the time of writing this petition Pius Acheampong is also the Constituency Secretary of Suame. I plea with the committee to refrain from nepotism, favoritism, God fatherhood and any other bias decision that will not reflect the values of our dear party.

Lastly, a cross section of members of our party has suffered same and denied from occupying the positions of polling stations and electoral area as secretaries due to fake and non-existence or the genuineness of certificate. **It shall be deemed to have breached the NPP's Constitution and will, accordingly, be sanctioned, including being disqualified from contesting the position. I humbly appeal to the vetting committee to carefully and impartial interpret rules 17(f), and 18 of Rules and Regulation Governing the Conduct of Constituency Executive elections. This was reiterated by our general secretary, Mr. Justin Frimpong Koduah Esq. at a press conference on Wednesday 18th February 2028 at 1:00 pm.**

If Mr. Pius Acheampong is not estopped from contesting the Constituency secretary, delegate might doubt the decision of the committee; create misunderstanding and apathy for the party in Suame because of the turndown or rejection of the decisions of The National Executive Committee (NEC) and the National Council (NC).

In conclusion, i hereby challenge the eligibility of Pius Acheampong to take part in the Suame constituency election and therefore request your good offices to duly disqualify him.

RULES & REGULATIONS FOR CONSTITUENCY EXECUTIVES ELECTIONS

1. Pursuant to Article 7(27) of the Party Constitution, the Constituency Executives Elections shall be conducted at a Constituency Delegates Conference.

Constituency Elections Committee

2. The Constituency Executive elections shall be conducted by a Constituency Elections Committee constituted as follows:
 - a) A National Representative appointed by the National Steering Committee
 - b) A Regional Representative appointed by the Regional Steering Committee
 - c) Chairman of the Constituency Council of Elders
 - d) Chairman of the Constituency Council of Patrons
 - e) A respected elderly woman appointed by the Constituency Executive Committee
 - f) The Constituency Research and Elections Officer
 - g) The Constituency IT Officer
3. A member of the Constituency Elections Committee shall NOT be eligible to contest in the Constituency elections.
4. Where any member of the Constituency Elections Committee intends to contest in the Constituency Elections, the Constituency Executive Committee shall appoint a replacement for him/her on the Elections Committee.
