POLICE RESTORE CALM FOLLOWING UNLAWFUL ASSEMBLY AT KROBO NURSING TRAINING COLLEGE

1. The Bono East Regional Police Command has restored calm following an unlawful assembly by students of the Krobo Nursing Training College near Techiman on Monday 27th July 2026.
2. Police personnel responded after receiving information that the students had embarked on an unlawful assembly without prior notification to the Police. Officers engaged the student leadership in an attempt to dissuade them from proceeding, but the students marched towards Techiman town.
3. During efforts to maintain law and order, some of the students pelted stones at Police personnel, Police vehicles, and members of the public, resulting in the injury of one Police officer.
4. To prevent further attacks and restore order, Police fired warning shots, after which the crowd dispersed. Two [02] students, Paulina Felayire aged twenty-seven [27] and Gabriel Boadu aged twenty-one [21], were arrested for allegedly pelting stones and are currently assisting investigations.
5. Preliminary investigations indicate that the students were protesting over concerns about feeding conditions at the College.
6. The situation is currently calm, with security reinforced on the campus and surrounding areas. The Ghana Police Service urges the public to use lawful means to address grievances and reminds organisers to notify the Police before holding public assemblies, as required by law.
