PEOPLE'S NATIONAL PARTY (PNP) JOINS NPP DEMONSTRATION IN DEFENCE OF DEMOCRACY

The People's National Party (PNP) wishes to announce that it will participate in tomorrow's demonstration in defence of democracy and the rule of law.

Our decision is guided by our unwavering belief that democracy must guarantee equal justice, freedom of expression, and equal protection under the law for every Ghanaian, regardless of political affiliation.

The PNP is concerned by what we view as increasing signs of selective justice, where allegations involving members of the opposition appear to be pursued aggressively while similar allegations involving individuals associated with the governing party are perceived to receive different treatment. Such perceptions undermine public confidence in our democratic institutions.

We are equally disturbed by what we believe is the growing intimidation of women who exercise their constitutional right to free expression. No woman should fear arrest, prosecution, or harassment for expressing her views in a democratic society, especially when abusive political rhetoric from other quarters appears to attract little or no accountability.

The defence of democracy is not about protecting any political party. It is about protecting the constitutional rights and freedoms of every Ghanaian. A democracy that applies justice selectively and tolerates unequal treatment risks losing the confidence of the people it exists to serve.

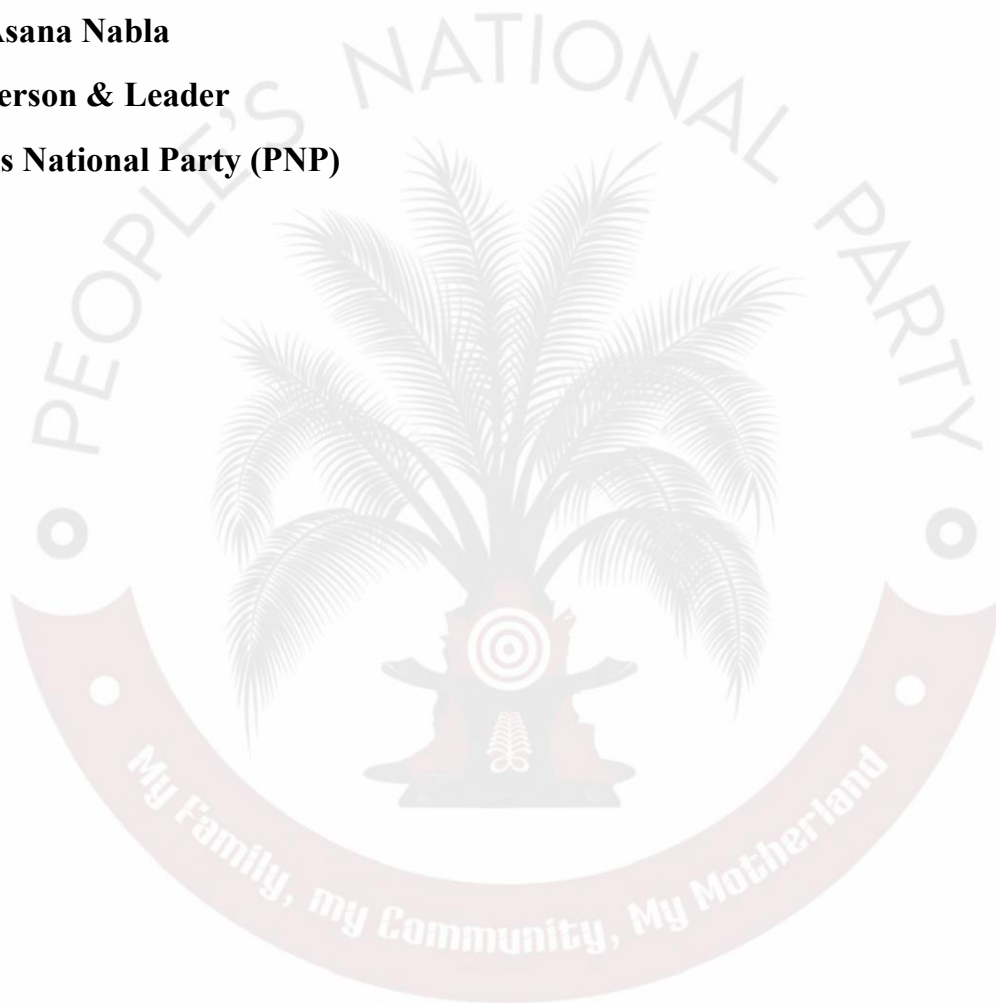
The PNP therefore stands with all Ghanaians who believe that the rule of law must be applied fairly, justice must be impartial, and democracy must remain the foundation of our Republic.
