AGGRIEVED GOLD COAST CUSTOMERS TO HOLD PUBLIC GATHERING AND PETITION PRESIDENT MAHAMA

The Leadership of the Aggrieved Customers of Gold Coast Fund Management wishes to remind all members, the media and the general public about our forthcoming public gathering to demand urgent action on the payment of our outstanding locked-up funds.

The programme is scheduled as follows:

Day/Date: Tuesday, September 1, 2026

Converging Point: Forecourt of Ebenezer Presby Church, Osu, Accra

Time : 9:00 a.m. – 11:00 a.m.

At 11:00 a.m., buses will be provided to transport ALL protesters from the converging point directly to the Jubilee House for the presentation of our petition to His Excellency President John Dramani Mahama.

NO PROTESTER WILL WALK FROM THE CONVERGING POINT TO JUBILEE HOUSE. All participants will be conveyed by the buses provided for the exercise.

We therefore call on **ALL AGGRIEVED GOLD COAST CUSTOMERS** to attend in their numbers. Our greatest strength is our numbers, unity and peaceful determination. This is a critical moment for us to demonstrate that, after years of waiting, we remain united in our demand for justice.

We equally invite affected customers and individuals of other collapsed financial institutions to join this peaceful action. The financial sector crisis affected thousands of Ghanaian families, and our collective voice can help draw renewed attention to the plight of all victims whose funds remain outstanding.

We also appeal to the media houses, journalists, civil society organisations, religious bodies, traditional leaders and the general public to support and amplify our legitimate call for the government to expedite action towards the payment of outstanding locked-up funds.

We assure the authorities and the public that the gathering and subsequent movement will be peaceful, orderly and disciplined.

We urge every affected customer to make a special effort to be present. Let us come together in our numbers and make our voice impossible to ignore.
