UPDATE ON NATIONAL EXECUTIVE ELECTIONS

Pursuant to Article 10(2) of the Party Constitution, and other relevant provisions in the Party's Constitution as amended, these rules and regulations shall govern the National Executives Elections.

The National Elections Committee hereby announces an update of the National Executives Elections as follows:

1. Opening and Closing of Nominations

- a. Opening and closing of Nominations: **17th to 22nd August 2026**
- b. Filing of nomination: **23rd to 27th August 2026**
- c. Vetting : **31st August to 3rd September 2026**
- d. Publication of Vetting results: **5th September 2026**
- e. Appeals – **6th to 7th September 2026**
- f. NEC/NC: **10th September 2026**
- g. Notice of Poll : **14th September 2026**
- h. Elections : **3rd October 2026**

2. National Elections Committee

The National Executive Elections shall be conducted by the National Elections Committee constituted as follows:

3. Eligibility and Qualification

A person shall not be eligible to contest in the National Executive Elections unless he/she satisfies all the following conditions:

- a. is a known and active registered party member for at least two (2) years;
 - b. is of good character;
 - c. member in good standing (must have paid membership dues at least in the past two (2) years.
 - d. has paid the prescribed fees
 - e. . has been determined by the National Vetting Committee to qualify to contest for a National Office position.
 - f. in the case of the National Youth Organizer, the aspiring candidate should not attain the age of forty (40) years.
 - g. the nomination form has been endorsed by at least one member in good standing across the sixteen (16) regions.
4. It is the duty of an aspiring National Executive to satisfy the National Elections Committee that he/she has met all the above qualifications and eligibility requirements.
 5. A member of the National Elections Committee shall NOT be eligible to contest in the National Elections.
 6. Where any member of the National Elections Committee intends to contest in the National Elections, the National Executive Committee shall appoint a replacement on the Elections Committee.
 7. The Vetting Committee is composed as follows:

8. The National Vetting Committee shall be responsible for the vetting of all aspirants.
9. The National Vetting Committee shall recommend the disqualification of any aspirant where it determines that the aspirant does not satisfy the eligibility requirements for election as a National Officer.
10. The Appeals Committee is composed as follows:

11. A Party Member or aspirant for National Office who is aggrieved by a decision of the National Vetting Committee may submit a written petition to the National Appeals Committee.
12. The National Appeals Committee shall make a determination on the petition within 48 hours.
13. Where a petitioner is dissatisfied with the outcome of the Appeals Committee's decision, he or she may lodge a further appeal with the National Executive Committee, whose decision shall be final and binding.

Nomination Fees

14. Nomination Forms shall be acquired from the National Elections Committee or at the National Secretariat at the following costs:
 - a) National Chairman – GH¢50,000
 - b) Vice Chairpersons – GH¢ 30,000
 - c) General Secretary – GH¢25,000
 - d) All other positions – GH¢10,000
 - e) Special Wings (Nasara, Women, and Youth) – GH¢8,000

15. Payment for nomination forms will be accepted in cash or by cash cheque at the National Headquarters at Asylum Down. Upon payment of the prescribed fee, the aspirant will be issued with an official receipt, upon presentation of which the appropriate nomination form will be issued. Nomination forms may also be downloaded from the Party's website. However, an aspirant who downloads a form must still pay the prescribed nomination fee in cash or by cash cheque and obtain an official receipt before the completed form can be accepted for filing.
16. The National Elections Committee shall provide the Notice of Poll, which shall be posted at the National Secretariat at least one (1) clear week to the date of the elections.
17. The Electoral Commission of Ghana shall conduct the elections under the supervision of the National Elections Committee in line with the Political Parties Act 2000 (ACT 574).
18. The positions to be contested for are:
 - a) National Chairperson
 - b) National Vice Chairpersons
 - c) General Secretary
 - d) National Treasurer
 - e) National Organiser
 - f) National Women Organiser
 - g) National Youth Organiser
 - h) National Nasara Organiser
 - i) National Communication Director

Persons Entitled to Vote

19. Pursuant to Article 10(3) of the Party Constitution, the Electoral College for the election of National Executives include:
 - a. All Members of the National Council;
 - b. All Members of the National Executive Committee; -
 - c. All Members of the Regional Executive Committees;
 - d. All Members of the Constituency Executive Committees;
 - e. All Members of the External Branch Executive Committees;
 - f. All Members of the National Council of Elders;
 - g. The National TESCON Coordinator;
 - h. The TESCON President from each recognized tertiary institution in the

country;

- i. Thirty (30) National Patrons elected from among themselves
- j. Founding Members across the country, who are signatories to the registration documents of the Party at the Electoral Commission;
- k. All Party Members of Parliament;
- l. Special Organs of the Party (National Women, National Youth, and National Nasara Wings)

National Women's Wing

20. Every female delegate at the National Delegates Conference shall be eligible to vote for the position of the National Women Organizer including TESCON Women Commissioners.

National Youth Wing

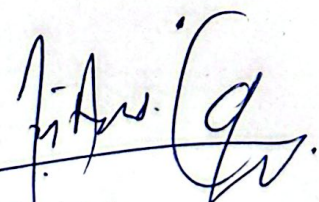
21. Every youth delegate at the National Delegates Conference including TESCON Presidents from accredited institution shall be eligible to vote for the position of the National Youth Organizer

National Nasara Wing

22. The Nasara Organizer shall be elected at the National Delegates Conference by;
 - a. National Nasara Coordinator and Deputies
 - b. All former National Nasara Coordinators and Deputies
 - c. All Regional Nasara Coordinators and Deputies
 - d. All Constituency Nasara Coordinators and Deputies
 - e. All External Branch Nasara Coordinators and Deputies
 - f. All TESCON Nasara Coordinators
23. The presence of at least one-third (1/3) of the delegates of the National Delegates Conference shall be necessary to constitute a quorum of the National Delegates Conference.
