**REQUEST FOR INFORMATION UNDER THE RIGHT TO
INFORMATION ACT, 2019 (ACT 989) ON PROPOSED PARTNERSHIPS
BETWEEN GOVERNMENT OF GHANA THROUGH THE MINISTRY
OF HEALTH AND PRIVATE ENTITIES IN RESPECT OF AGENDA 111
HOSPITALS**

I write pursuant to the Right to Information Act, 2019 (Act 989) to request access to information and records relating to all proposals, negotiations, agreements or arrangements between the Government of Ghana through the Ministry of Health and private entities concerning the completion, financing, management, operation, ownership or other involvement in the Agenda 111 hospitals.

Specifically, I request:

1. The names and identities of all private entities, companies, organisations, religious bodies, foundations, investors or other non-governmental entities that have, since January 2025, expressed an interest in, proposed to, or been invited by Government to partner in relation to completion of any Agenda 111 hospital.
2. Copies of all proposals, expressions of interest, letters, correspondence and communications submitted by such entities.
3. Copies of all agreements, memoranda of understanding, framework agreements, term sheets, heads of terms, PPP agreements or other contractual instruments executed, negotiated or proposed with any such entity.

4. The names and locations of all Agenda 111 hospitals covered by, or proposed to be covered by, each partnership.
5. The financial terms and structure of each proposed partnership, including the respective financial contributions and obligations of Government and the private entity.
6. Details of any proposed ownership, lease, concession, management, operation or control of any Agenda 111 hospital by a private entity.
7. Copies of all Cabinet, Ministerial, Parliamentary or other governmental approvals, decisions or directives relating to any such partnership.
8. Copies of all legal opinions, due diligence reports, feasibility studies, financial models, valuation reports and technical assessments prepared in connection with any proposed partnership.
9. Details of any procurement or selection process used or proposed for selecting private partners.
10. Copies of minutes and records of meetings between Government officials and prospective private partners concerning Agenda 111.
11. The current status of each proposed partnership, indicating whether it is:
 - i. under consideration;
 - ii. under negotiation;
 - iii. approved;
 - iv. concluded;
 - v. suspended; or
 - vi. abandoned.

12. Details of any completed or ongoing transfer, lease, concession, management or operational arrangement involving an Agenda 111 facility and a private entity.
13. Any document setting out the criteria or policy framework adopted by Government for determining which private entities may participate in the completion of Agenda 111 Hospitals.
14. Any document establishing the legal and institutional framework under which private entities are permitted to participate in the completion, ownership, financing, management or operation of Agenda 111 hospitals.
15. Any other records in the custody or control of the institution relating to proposed private-sector participation in Agenda 111.

For clarity, this request is not limited to any particular private entity or organisation. It covers all private entities that have approached Government, been approached by Government, submitted proposals, expressed interest, entered negotiations or otherwise sought to participate in Agenda 111.

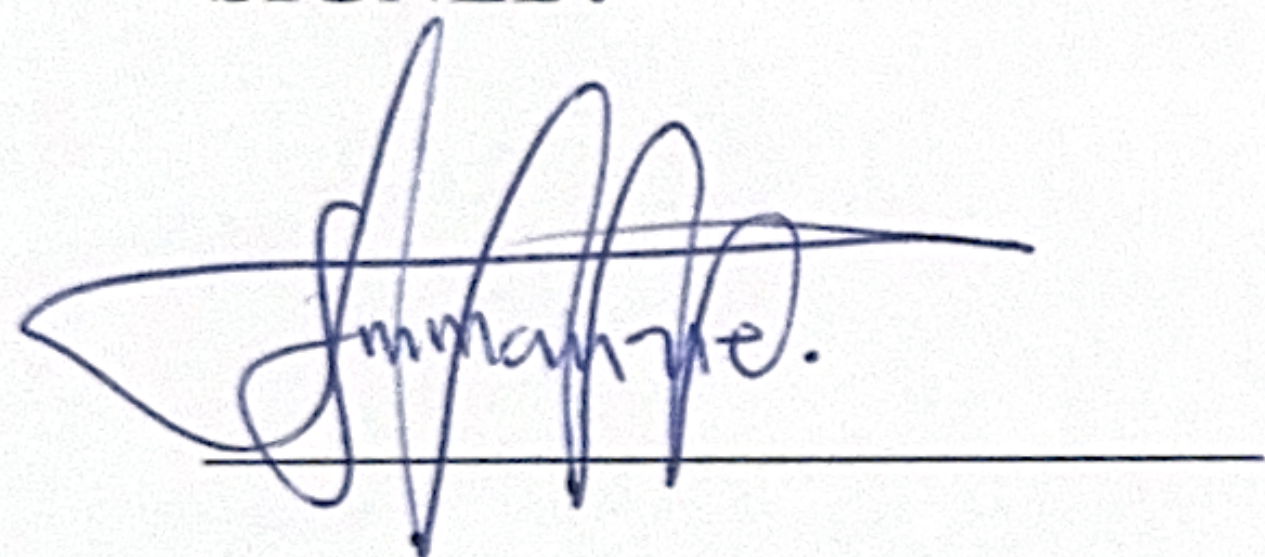
We respectfully draw the attention of the Ministry to section 23(1) of the Right to Information Act, 2019 (Act 989), which requires the Information Officer to take a decision on an application for access to information and communicate that decision to the applicant in writing within fourteen days of receipt of the application.

Accordingly, we look forward to receiving the Ministry's written response within the statutory period prescribed by the Act.
